



GUIDELINES FOR STUDENT PARKING

Important Notes

1. Students will need to know their Student ID when they go to the above TicketsDonations url. Their Student ID is their gateway to making a purchase through Hometown.
2. Students should be on the lookout for a Hometown Ticketing email subsequent to their parking permit purchase next week. The Hometown email will provide students with a scannable barcode and also Hometown will send students a completed (by Hometown) CHS form (Google doc.) via email.
3. Beginning on August 24th (8am- 4pm) students may enter CHS on weekdays to pick up their parking permits. Be sure to bring your receipt and form (barcode + form). Please wear your face covering. All students will have their temperature screened.

NOTE: THIS IS NOT A PURCHASE FORM. All purchases must be made online at the above link. AFTER you have completed the online purchase of your parking pass, PLEASE BRING the proof of online payment (digital/printed barcode) to receive a parking permit.

ONLINE SALES WILL BE AVAILABLE BEGINNING ON THE FOLLOWING DATES

Senior Mentor parking permits will be available online for sale **on August 18, 2020.**

Senior parking permits will be available online for sale **on August 19, 2020.**

Junior parking permits will be available online for sale **on August 20, 2020.**

Sophomore parking permits will be available online for sale **on August 21, 2020.**

All student-driven motor vehicles must have a C.H.S. registered parking sticker in order to park on our campus. The registration and sticker will cost **\$60**. If the original is lost, a replacement will be issued at a cost of \$20.00.

Students must have a **VALID** Ohio Driver's License **No temporary driver permits will be accepted.**

Students can have their parking permit revoked without refund for any of the following occurrences (but not limited to) during the school year:

1. Any out of school suspensions,
2. Excessive tardies to school,
3. Driving in a manner that is perceived as reckless or unsafe by school personnel,
4. Loitering in the parking lot area, and/or
5. Violations of the Student Code of Conduct.

The administration or designee, law enforcement and law enforcement dogs may be used to patrol the school facilities and the surrounding grounds, including lockers, and parking areas. Use of the law enforcement dogs may be unannounced and random. If a trained law enforcement canine alerts a particular vehicle, locker or other container, it shall create reasonable suspicion to search that vehicle, locker or container in accordance with this policy.

Chardon High School reserves the right to amend, delete, or add to guidelines during the course of the school year.

Parking permits are NON-Transferable and are NOT to be shared with a friend or sold to another student.
