

## Sixth Grade Supply List

Welcome to Chardon Middle School! We look forward to a productive and exciting 2017-2018 school year. Please refer to the following list as you do your "Back to School" shopping.

Keep in mind that you will have 4 core subjects (math, science, social studies, and language arts) all year and some exploratory classes (band, chorus, art, health, technology, physical education, etc.) at different times throughout the year. **BE SURE TO LABEL ALL SUPPLIES.**

- 1 - 2 inch binder (**heavy duty** not flimsy) or *Trapper* to hold a folder for each class (approximately 6)
- 2 – 1 inch binders (**CLEAR-VIEW heavy duty with pockets - not flimsy**) for LA and SS
- 1 Composition Book (Black & White)- for LA
- 1 One-subject spiral notebook for Science
- 2 sets of dividers (5 count) with tabs - for LA and SS binders
- 2 - 1 subject spiral graph paper notebooks for math (one per semester)
- Post-Its- several packs
- Highlighters (4-pack- assorted)
- Dark blue and /or black pens (need all year) – NO gel or metallic pens
- Red pens (need all year)
- Pencils (need all year) and small pencil sharpener
- 1 bottle of glue or glue sticks
- 4 dry erase markers (NOT yellow) – turn in 2 markers to math teacher
- 1 package colored pencils (12-24 pack)
- An **inexpensive** set of ear-buds (**NO big headphones**) to keep in Chromebook case to take to all classes
- Portable mouse (**OPTIONAL**)
- Loose-leaf Paper (several packs)- Wide lined-need all year
- Scissors
- Supply/Pencil Pouch (that will hold a calculator) that you will take to every class, every day
- 2 boxes of tissues (give to Advisory teacher)
- About 20 page protectors (10 for LA and 10 for SS)



**Calculator:** While calculators are not used on a daily basis in math class, they are used occasionally and are permitted on parts of the Ohio AIR State test. It is not necessary to go out and buy a special calculator for 6th grade. However, if you choose to, here are the recommended calculators for the 6th Grade Ohio AIR State Test:
