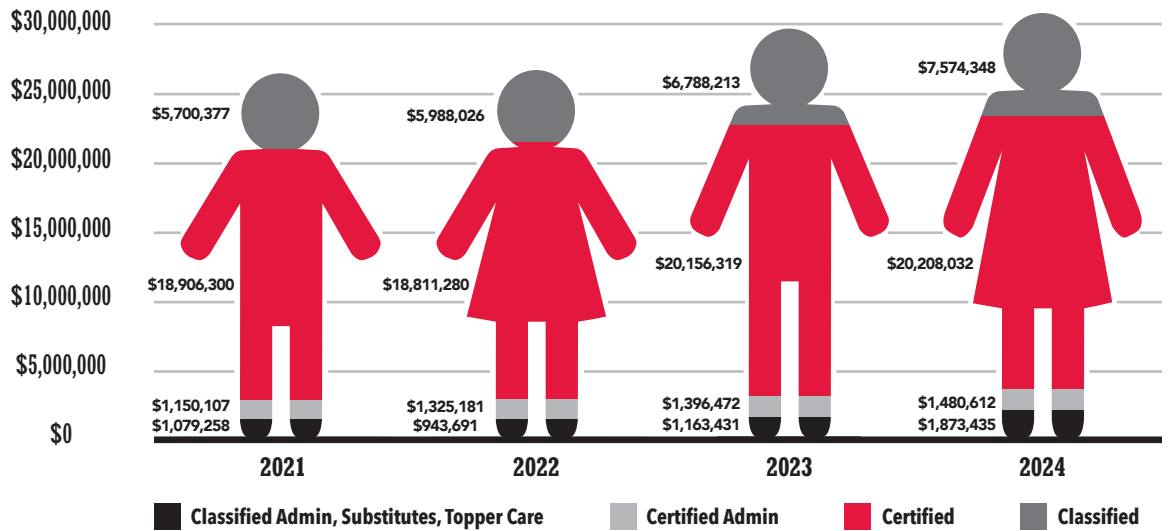
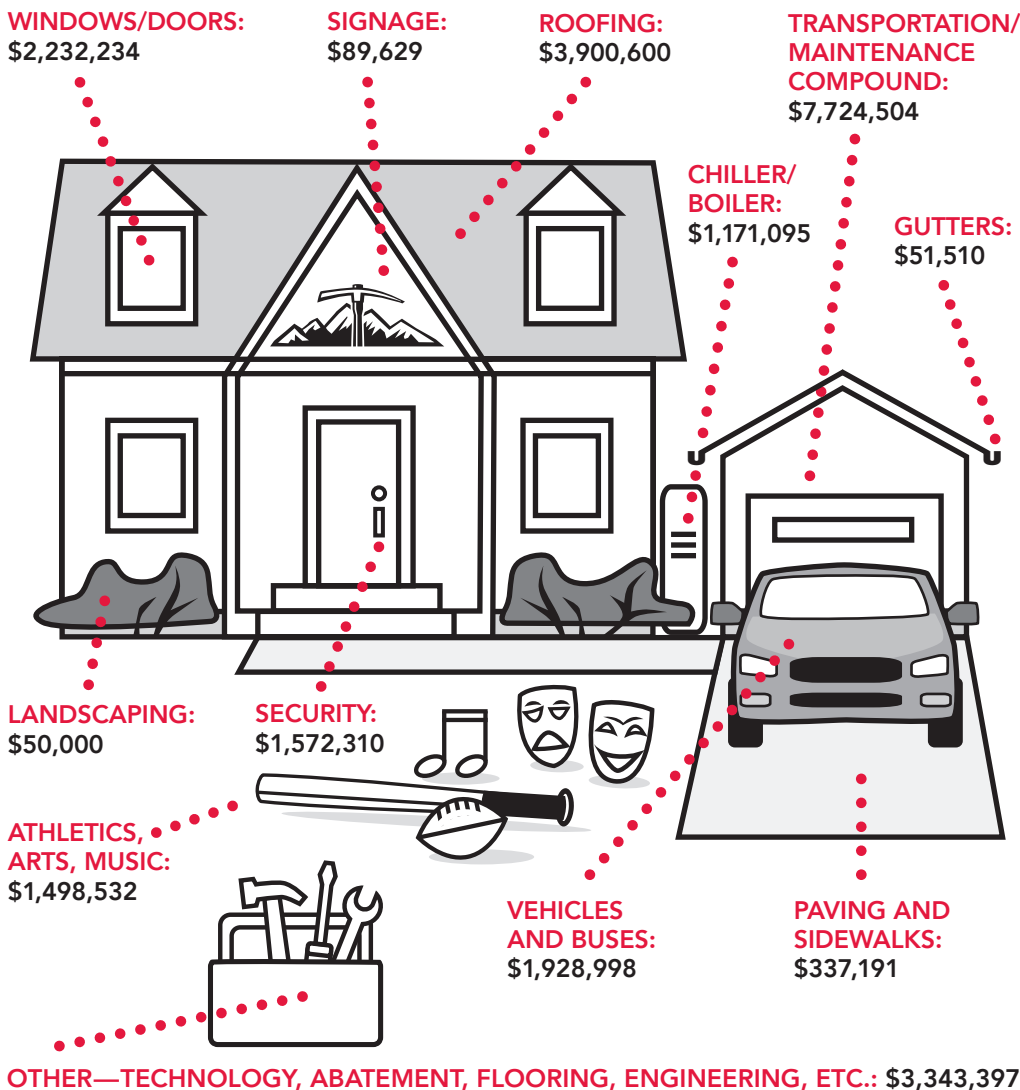

District Wide Capital Expenditures 2022-2025—\$23.9M



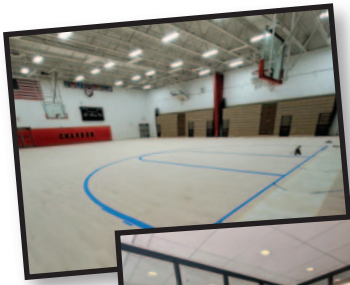
Financial Data

- Secondary source of revenue—State funding 14.3%
- Total annual budget—\$63M

- Chardon Middle School (714 students, grades 4-7), built 1965, additions in 1974

- Munson Elementary School (238 students, grades 1-3), built 1955, additions in 1959, and 1974
- Park Elementary School (223 students, grades 1-3), built 1938

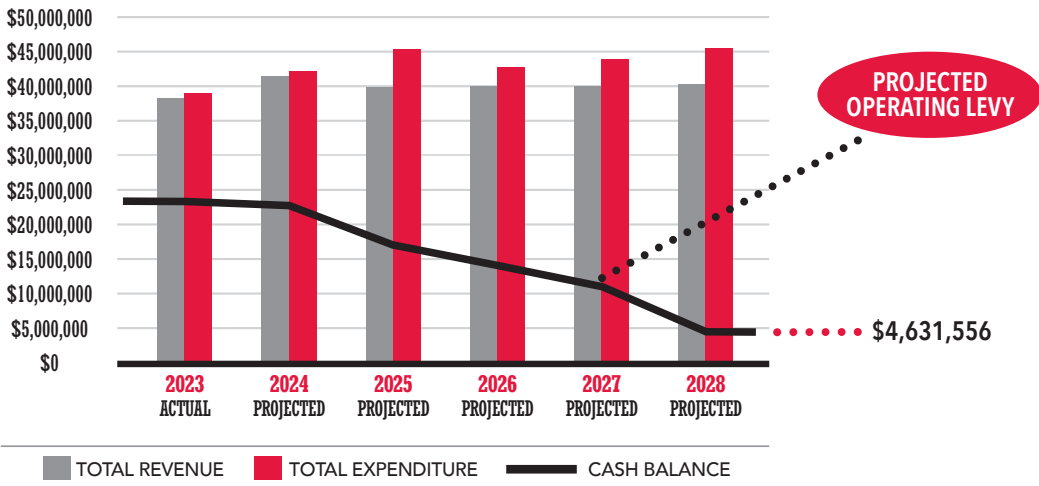
