

Morning drop-off procedure:

- 1. Beginning at 9:10AM, vehicles may begin to line up for drop-off.
- 2. Vehicles may pull in at the entrance closest to the Munson Township Park from Bass Lake Road and stay to the left as much as possible.
 - *Please pull up as close as safely possible to the vehicle in front of you
- 3. If the line happens to back up onto Bass Lake Road, Munson Elementary parents are permitted to pull into the Peach Lutheran Church parking lot until the line subsides.
- 4. Vehicles will line up, loop around the back parking lot and pull next to the back of the building.
- 5. Staff will open the doors and begin to let students in (parents/guardians are not permitted to enter the building from here) at **9:10 am**.
- 6. Students should exit the vehicle from the door closest to the building if possible.
- 7. Parents/guardians are encouraged to **stay in their vehicles**.
- 8. The doors will be closed at 9:20 am.
 - *The drop off window is from 9:10-9:20, parents/guardians who arrive around 9:15 usually have significantly less wait.
- 9. If you arrive after 9:20 am, parents/guardians will need to bring their student to the <u>front</u> door and come into the building to sign their child in.

Afternoon pick-up procedure:

- 1. Starting at **3:15 pm**, vehicles may pull in at the entrance closest to the Munson Township Park from Bass Lake Road and stay to the left as much as possible.
- 2. Vehicles will line up and loop around the back parking lot (just like drop-off) and pull next to the back of the building.
- 3. Each car will display the **pick-up** tag in their front windshield while in line.
- 4. Starting at 3:40pm, students will be released from the back door, four students at a time, to the cars with their child's corresponding tag.
- 5. Please have your students enter your vehicle from the same side that the building is on.

Drop off/pick up procedure notes:

- Each student will be given (2) car tags on the first day of school.
- Please make sure to send a completed 2022-2023 After School Plans note. This will be handed out to students to take home on the first day of school,
- We have 50-80 regular pick-ups per day. In order for this to work, vehicles must <u>pull up</u> as close as possible to the vehicle in front of them.
- Families picking up students are not to get out of their cars.
- Students do not need to be signed out when exiting from the back of the building
- No students will be released from the back door to parents/guardians not in cars.
