

Lakeland Community College's College Credit Plus Program (CCP) offers high school students the opportunity to enroll at Lakeland on a part-time or full-time basis, and earn college credit which may also be used to fulfill their high school graduation requirements.

The intent of the CCP program is to offer a broad range of college level classes which provide educational opportunities not typically available in high school. Admission into this program is open to students who have clearly demonstrated the ability to handle college-level coursework.

Criteria for participation

Interested students and their parents should follow the 5 steps below to determine eligibility to participate in the College Credit Plus Program (CCP).

- Step 1:** Attend a high school CCP information session.
- Step 2:** File a CCP application with Lakeland Community College.
- Step 3:** Submit high school transcripts.
- Step 4:** Register for COMPASS placement exam and achieve a minimum placement level of ENGL 1110 and MATH 0950, OR, achieve an ACT minimum score of 18 in English AND 21 in math, OR, achieve an SAT minimum score of 450 in Critical Reading or 430 on Writing AND 500 in math.
- Step 5:** Attend a CCP registration session. Parents are required to attend with their child.
